CIRCA 1958: BREAKING GROUND IN AMERICAN ARTSunday, September 21, 2008 - Sunday, January 04, 2009ObjectsThe Legend of LotEatTheta BetaText EntriesDescription/Short SummaryCirca 1958: Breaking Ground in American ArtAckland Art Museum, University of North Carolina, Chapel HillSeptember 21, 2008 - January 4, 2009Roni Feinstein, Guest CuratorBy the late fifties, many observers and participants in the American art scene regarded Abstract Expressionism, which was well into its "second generational" phase with artists working both in abstract and figurative styles, to be both academic and stale. While participating at a panel at New York's Tenth Street Club in 1958 entitled "Has the Situation Changed?," Alfred Barr, Director of New York's Museum of Modern Art, bemoaned the fact that a "rebellion" against Abstract Expressionism's dominance had not yet occurred and he called upon younger artists to reject their elders with greater vehemence. He concluded, "I hope that I am wrong [and] that something new is happening." Indeed it was, as Barr soon discovered. A year later, the exhibition "Sixteen Americans" held at the Museum of Modern Art featured a single gesture painter of the New York School (Al Leslie) amid a host of artists who had emerged as leaders of the avant-garde. It was in 1958 that Jasper Johns and Jack Youngerman, who were featured in the show, had their first solo exhibitions, as did Lee Bontecou, Red Grooms, Marisol, Agnes Martin, Claes Oldenburg, and Al Held. In the same year, Robert Rauschenberg unveiled a large group of Combines, John Chamberlain showed sculptures made with automobile parts, Louise Nevelson exhibited her first environment and Frank Stella, Kenneth Noland and Robert Ryman turned their attention to painting stripes, targets and monochromes, respectively. This exhibition will highlight a pivotal moment in American art when viable alternatives to Abstract Expressionism arose and any number of major artists first received recognition. Circa 1958: Breaking Ground in American Art will focus upon the two primary directions that emerged at this time: Assemblage Art on the one hand and Hard-Edge and Post-Painterly Abstraction on the other. Artists working in these modes sought to rid themselves of the painterly gestures that dominated the artistic practice of their elders as well as of the romantic rhetoric surrounding their work, favoring instead more literal attitudes about the materials and processes of art making. Assemblage artists manipulated a wide variety of commonplace materials in real space. Initially referred to as "Neo-Dada" for seeming anti-art qualities, Assemblage expanded definitions of art, its focus on the stuff of life laying the groundwork for Environments and Happenings in the late 1950s and Pop and Fluxus by the early 1960s. In contrast, Hard-Edge and Post-Painterly Abstraction involved an emphasis on the formal elements of art making: line, shape, color, form, etc. The simple, pre-conceived structures favored by many of these artists set the stage for Minimal Art in the next decade. The exhibition will present surveys of both Assemblage and post-painterly forms of abstraction, with work dating from the late 1950s by approximately sixty leading artists. Paintings, sculptures, mixed media artwork, installation pieces, and film will be included and installed in such a way as to elucidate the evolution of each tendency as well as the breadth of individual expression and interpretation contained within. Throughout the exhibition, supplementary materials including descriptive wall texts, photographic

documentation, and statements by artists and writers will underline the artworks' intellectual and conceptual contexts. In the gallery highlighting abstraction, a group of works by Ellsworth Kelly, Leon Polk Smith, and Myron Stout will appear at the entrance to exemplify artists who produced antigestural work early in the 1950s, but did not receive recognition under later in the decade when Abstract Expressionism was on the wane. Works by Frank Stella, Al Held, Morris Louis, and Yayoi Kusama, dating from circa 1958, will suggest the richness and visual complexity of this defining period in art. At a later point in the installation, significant early pieces of the late '50s and early '60s by Robert Ryman, Agnes Martin, Donald Judd, Tony Smith, and Larry Bell will signal the emergence of Minimal Art. The gallery devoted to Assemblage will feature works by Robert Rauschenberg, Jasper Johns, Louise Nevelson, George Segal, Richard Stankiewicz, and Lee Bontecou. Early works by Claes Oldenburg, Jim Dine, Roy Lichtenstein, Andy Warhol, and James Rosenquist will illustrate the transition from Assemblage into Pop. Throughout the exhibition, clusters of works by California artists working in abstract, Assemblage, and early Pop imagist modes, among them Bruce Conner, Lorser Feitelson, and Ed Rucha, will be set in contrast to pieces by their New York contemporaries to elucidate the continuities and distinctions among them. The breakthroughs that occurred in California ceramics at this time will be highlighted as well. Circa 1958 will reveal that while a cool, machine-like aesthetic characterized artistic production in the 1960s, art that arose in rebellion against Abstract Expressionism in the late fifties generally retained vestiges of the earlier movement, particularly regarding the persistence of gesture. Assemblage as a whole tended to an expressionistic handling of materials in space, as will be seen in John Chamberlain's sculpture of crushed automobile parts and Allan Kaprow's untitled 1959 installation composed of a ladder, chicken wire, and newspaper. As was typical of work by artists of their generation, these artists sought not to convey emotion, but a sense of the immediacy and physicality of the contemporary urban environment. Even so-called Post-Painterly Abstraction, although impersonal in spirit, was often "soft" around the edges and quasi-gestural in the late '50s, as will be seen in an early stripe painting by Frank Stella, one of Robert Ryman's first monochromes, Kenneth Noland's stained target, and Al Held's muscular, abstract painting of 1959. By the early 1960s, all such traces of the artist's hand were eradicated. While soft edges were replaced by hard in the work of the abstract artists, after the Museum of Modern Art's The Art of Assemblage exhibition of 1961, Assemblage declined as a mainstream style, many of its practitioners moving on to Pop and alternate modes. This exhibition will demonstrate that although Assemblage and Hard-Edge Abstraction are generally conceived of in terms of polar opposites, as the former tended to feature a sculptural engagement with "junk" and the other a preoccupation with painted form, an overlap of concerns was often seen in the late fifties. Jasper Johns' Target, for example, which presents an abstract, holistic structure made up of newspaper collage, bracketed the two tendencies and influenced them both. The early production of both Robert Indiana and Yavoi Kusama alternated between Assemblage and post-painterly modes. Circa 1958 will include Ray Johnson and Yayoi Kusama. whose works fell into obscurity decades ago, but have in recent years been reexamined, their art newly vital and appreciated. Artists such as Chryssa, Gabriel Kohn, and Lenore Tawney, whose careers are due for revaluation, will also be prominently featured. Looking back after half-a-century, the work featured in Circa 1958 remains significant because it represents a groundbreaking moment in the history of art, one in which artists rebelled against a prevailing trend and extended their work in new directions, opening up a multitude of possibilities for the future. The vast majority of the artists represented in the exhibition had their first solo shows or exhibited major bodies of work that

All three artists live and work in Los Angeles and have been very instrumental in the development of the vibrant Los Angeles art scene of the 1960s. A special interplay between utopia and dystopia characterized creativity in Los Angeles during the post-war period. The dream of 'sun and surf' and happiness in Hollywood was juxtaposed with the exploitation of people and dreams. Far away from New York, the American art capital at that time, artists found an environment in which they were allowed to experiment with new materials, techniques, and contents, all of them bearing the stamp of the Beat influence.

Our gallery has dedicated solo shows to each of them last year. Each exhibition demonstrated how they have continuously developed their work over the years while at the same time remaining true to their initial ideas.

Larry Bell (USA, 1939) has explored the minimalist shape of the cube as early as 1960 in his cutting-edge painting Li'l Orphan Annie. Soon thereafter he started to experiment with glass and developed a technology called thin film deposition, a plating process that deposits vaporized metal alloys to the surfaces of glass. While thin aluminum and metal channels hold together the six panes of his early vapor coated glass cubes, he continually searched to perfect his techniques over the years. The 12-inch cubes on display in Los Angeles NOW have neither frames nor lines where the sides of the cube connect: they seem to float in space. The light that radiates, reflects and transmits from each cube becomes an interactive environment with the surrounding space. Larry Bell resumes the theme of cubes in his Fraction works where he combines small pieces of vapor coated materials, such as strips of mylar and film laminate, to form collages. Working on the same premise as the cubes they question the viewer's perception and, depending on light and the viewer's angle, radiate in different colors and hues.

Joe Goode (USA, 1937) has always been keen to experiment and, since the 1960s, has worked at creating pictures and visual impressions, which he himself has not seen before. The medium of photography is one of the constants in his search for new ways of seeing and perceiving, although he is mainly a painter. "Seeing through things" has been the subject matter in all his work and has guided not only the selection of his topics such as milk bottles, windows, cloudy skies, fire and tornados but also the application of material and techniques. After a studio fire in 2005 Joe Goode started a new series of work in which he paints with colourless gel, pigments and acrylic paint on digital prints of highly enlarged photographs. The innovative application of the gel ranges from milky white to

complete transparency and adds an additional, translucid quality to each painting. For this exhibition Joe Goode has resumed the milk bottles theme, which references his famous milk bottle paintings from the 1960s. In Stage Fright and Encore the gel reminds of milk splashing out of a gigantic milk bottle, while the topic of transparency is taken up in Studies of the Past, a series of photographs and acrylic paint printed on wafer-thin, Japanese paper.

Ed Moses (USA, 1926) is known for his use of chance procedures and unusual ways of applying paint to canvas with tools other than the conventional paintbrush. Moses attempts an immediacy that is spontaneous and full of physical action: pouring, dripping, run-offs, washings, turning the canvas over, printing back onto the canvas from pools of run-off paint. In his latest series for this show, he continues to experiment with methods and materials to produce highly original images that vibrate with movement and contrast brilliant color. 'Reversal' refers to reversing a painting by equating the backside with the actual painting while 'Poppey' is like a vibrant bouquet of colors popping out. His works on mylar, Brack Black an Brack 2 reflect his abstract skills in black and white.

The time of a season bringing together summer and winter, the urgency of the *here and now* and the quest for an elusive infinity, "A second of eternity" draws a journey inspired by the question and the experience of time, through a set of works from the Pinault Collection.


The story composed by the works brought together by a second of eternity explores the polysemy of the present time, alternately suspended, fleeting, inhabited by spectral presences, crossed by the theme of absence and incarnation. This cycle borrows its title from the work of Belgian artist Marcel Broodthaers A Second of Eternity (based on an idea by Charles Baudelaire) conceived in 1971, a film which briefly reveals the presence of artist by the simple figuration of his signature. The work sets the tone for an exhibition where the intensity of the presence of bodies and images is measured by the yardstick of their transience. It is a question, as in the words of Charles Baudelaire, of seizing "in a second the infinity of enjoyment" and contemplation.
